

Training on Single Window System (Industry) organized at Rajasthan

A two days state level training on Single Window Clearance System, was organized at Gita Mittal Foundation , Bajaj Nagar, Jaipur from 23rd Mar to 24th Mar 2011 by NIC Rajasthan, in coordination with Bureau of Investment Promotion (BIP) , Rajasthan. Nodal officers from the concern departments RIICO,JVVNL, Factory & Boilers, Medical Health (Drug Control),Technical Education, Agriculture & Commercial Taxes, covered in Phase-I of the system, along with Help desk staff of BIP attended the training program.

The objective of the program was to spread awareness among the participants about Single Window Clearance System and to provide operational training for using the web enabled software.

Participants made the dummy entries for entrepreneur, nodal agency and department level actions, and process flow also viewed for transactions. The queries of the participants were addressed and feedback of the participants was obtained.

He also interacted with participants about the training and hope for the smooth implementation of the software in the state.
